

### Qualifying Information

**Date:** August 26, 2024

**Site:** Oakmont Country Club

**Field Size:** Max of 60

**Qualifying Spots:** TBD\*

*\*The number of players to qualify will be as follows: Field size of 20 or less players, 2 will qualify; Field size of 21-39 players, 3 will qualify; Field size of 40-60, 4 will qualify. No alternate positions will be given out at Last Chance Qualifying.*

**Format:** The qualifying is scheduled for 18 holes of individual stroke play. Successful qualifiers will receive more information pertaining to the 41<sup>st</sup> Texas Mid-Amateur from the TGA via email after the qualifier.

**Approximate Yardage:** The qualifying yardage will be approximately 6,800 (Gold Tees). Best efforts will be made at the qualifying site to replicate a course set-up appropriate to the 41<sup>st</sup> Texas Mid-Amateur.

**Qualifying Registration:** There is no official on-site registration required. It is asked that players arrive at their respective starting tee 8-10 minutes prior to their starting time to receive additional information from the starter.

**Playoff:** Ties for the last qualifying spot will be broken by a sudden death hole-by-hole playoff. There will be no playoff for the medalist. The playoff will begin immediately after all scores have been approved and posted by the Official-in-Charge.

**Practice Round Information:** Practice rounds are available at the host club in advance of the qualifying date. Practice rounds are subject to availability. Players must contact the host club directly to schedule a practice round.

**Availability:** Saturday, August 24 and Sunday, August 25 after 2:00 PM. Players may book 3 days out from the day of play.

**Rate:** \$55.00 (plus tax).

### Policies & Procedures

**Registration:** Last Chance qualifying registration will open at 9:00 AM on Monday, August 19, and close at 5:00 PM on Friday, August 23. Players who failed to qualify through sectional qualifying are eligible to register. Player's who earned an alternate position through sectional qualifying will not forfeit their alternate status if they register for Last Chance qualifying.

**Transportation:** Players may walk or ride at their discretion during qualifying rounds. Carts are included as part of the qualifying entry fee. Push/pull carts are permitted at TGA qualifying. **Players will be assigned a specific cart and only club golf carts will be allowed (no private carts will be allowed). Carts will be identified and assigned by a TGA Cart Sign with player names.** There may not be more than two (2) riders per cart at any time with two (2) carts per group.

**Caddies:** Caddies are permitted. Caddies must adhere to the TGA Code of Conduct and dress code. As a reminder, players are responsible for the actions of their caddies. See [TGA Men's Competition Policies](#) for complete details.

**'One-Seat' Policy:** When riding in a golf cart, there may not be more than two (2) riders per cart at any time. The player can ride in or move a golf cart with another player's caddie in it, so long as the player whose caddie is in the cart is not riding in another cart at the same time. **Withdraw from Qualifying:** Players needing to withdraw from Last Chance qualifying should contact TGA Tournament Manager, [Owen Kinney](#), or TGA Tournament Director, [Justin Guthrie](#), ahead of the scheduled qualifying.

**Score Posting:** At the conclusion of qualifying, each player's score will be automatically posted by the TGA as a 'C', or Competition score, to their World Handicap System GHIN number. Please do not enter your own score from the qualifying round as this will result in a double post.
