What a year 2024 was! Thank you all for your help and we can't wait to see everyone in 2025 to kick things off for another great season.


2024 Players of the Year Announced



Scottie Scheffler wins Hero World Challenge and announced as 2024 PGA Tour Player of the Year

Scottie Scheffler was overwhelmingly named the PGA Tour Player of the Year. The Texan and LJT Alum topped finalists Xander Schauffele and Rory McIlroy for the honor, marking his third consecutive win of the prestigious Jack Nicklaus Award. Only Tiger Woods and McIlroy have won the award at least three times. Scheffler's win will seven PGA Tour victories in 2024, including the Masters, THE PLAYERS, and TOUR Championship. Scheffler's accolades also included leading the Tour in top 10 finishes, scoring average, and multiple statistical categories. He became the first player to win THE PLAYERS, Masters, and TOUR Championship in a single season, with additional victories in four Signature Events. The inaugural tournament, held in 2023 at Stonebriar Country Club, was a tremendous success. Top golfers from across Texas and neighboring states returned to Stonebriar Country Club for the 2024 edition. Scottie Scheffler joined the event on Sunday, spending time with the kids, hitting golf balls, and playing a bit of pickleball—a sport he enjoys in his free time. The tournament features both individual play and a team-based format similar to collegiate competition. Henry Guan of Irving defended his individual stroke-play title with an impressive 61-67 performance, finishing at 16-under par over 36 holes. In the team competition, the Mulligan Masters—featuring Shiv Parmar of Selma, Henry Jackson of Corsicana, and Coleman Sides of Broken Arrow, Oklahoma—secured the win with a total score of 20-under par.
