### → GRANT

FOLLOWING THE CONSULTATION, THE TGA FOUNDATION PROVIDES UP TO \$15,000 IN RENOVATION GRANTS BASED UPON THE CONSULTATION RECOMMENDATIONS. THE ALLIED CITY IS THEN REQUIRED TO MATCH THE AMOUNT GRANTED BY THE TGA
