

PLAYER INFORMATION SHEET

FORMAT, FIELD SIZE & TEES

Medalist West #1 will be contested over 36 holes of individual stroke play at **Quicksand Golf Course**; the field is limited to 52 players (40 Open Division, 12 Senior Division). Each division will be playing from a different yardage. **Open Division – Gold Tees, Senior Division – Blue Tees.** Separate champions will be crowned in each division. In the event of a tie for first place a playoff will be contested if time allows for it, if not both players will receive full allocation of player of the year points.

REGISTRATION INFORMATION & ON COURSE WATER

There is no official on-site registration. Players should arrive to the tee 8-10 minutes prior to their starting time. There may not be water located on the golf course, please plan accordingly. For more information About the Medalist Series click [here](#).

PRACTICE ROUND AVAILABILITY

Each player is allowed one practice round at rate scheduled call golf shop for availability and to schedule a practice round (325) 482-8337.

STARTING TIMES/PAIRINGS

Starting times/pairings will be available on Tuesday, March 24th and can be found online at www.TXGA.org or by clicking [here](#). Tee times will begin at 10:00am for Saturday and 10:00am for Sunday's round. All tee times will start off #1 tee. Final round starting times/pairings will be available in the evening preceding play (approximately one hour after the completion of round one) online at www.TXGA.org and in the Golf Shop. Final round starting times will be re-drawn based on total score following the first round of play.

TRANSPORTATION/CADDIES

Players are encouraged to ride in the host club cart that is provided. Cart fees for all championship rounds are included in the entry fee. Carts are limited to two (2) riders at a time and two (2) carts per group. Caddies are permitted for the event. Players are responsible for supplying their own caddie for the championship. Caddies must abide by the host facility dress code. TGA 'one seat policy' is in effect for the competition.

PRIZES/AWARDS & POY POINTS

Golf Shop Merchandise certificates redeemable in the Quicksand Golf Course golf shop will be awarded to the top finishers. Medalist Player of the Year (POY) points will be awarded to the top finishers in both Open and Senior Divisions respectively.

SPECTATORS

Spectators are permitted and welcome to attend the tournament at no charge. Spectators are asked to observe host club policies while attending the tournament and practice appropriate golf etiquette. Spectator carts will not be permitted; those with documented ADA requirements may request use of a medical cart in the golf shop.

SKINS ELIGIBILITY

To remain eligible, players entered in the optional skins game must complete their respective round and post a score. Players who 'No Card' or 'Withdraw' from the event forfeit all possible skins earnings. To enter, please check in with the golf shop prior to the start of each round. The cost is \$10 per round and there will only be one pool (including Open and Senior Divisions).

WITHDRAWAL/NO SHOW POLICY
