Format: The qualifying is scheduled for 18 holes of individual stroke play. Successful qualifiers and alternates will receive more information pertaining to the 43rd Texas Mid-Amateur Presented by Hytera US from the TGA via email after the qualifier.

Approximate Yardage: The qualifying yardage will be approximately 6,800 (Mix of Blue and Black Tees). Best efforts will be made at the qualifying site to replicate a course set-up appropriate to the 43rd Texas Mid-Amateur Presented by Hytera US.

Qualifying Registration: There is no official on-site registration required. It is asked that players arrive at their respective starting tee 8-10 minutes prior to their starting time to receive additional information from the starter.

Playoff: Ties for the last qualifying spot will be broken by a sudden death hole-by-hole playoff. There will be no playoff for the medalist. The playoff will begin immediately after all scores have been approved and posted by the TGA.

Practice Round Information: Practice rounds are available at the host club in advance of the qualifying date. Practice rounds are subject to availability. Players must contact the host club directly to schedule a practice round.

Policies & Procedures

Transportation: Players may walk or ride at their discretion during qualifying rounds. Carts are included as part of the qualifying entry fee. Push/pull carts are permitted at TGA qualifying. Players will be assigned a specific cart and only club golf carts will be allowed (no private carts will be allowed). Carts will be identified and assigned by a TGA Cart Sign with player names. There may not be more than two (2) riders per cart at any time with two (2) carts per group.

Caddies: Caddies are permitted. Caddies must adhere to the TGA Code of Conduct and dress code. As a reminder, players are responsible for the actions of their caddies. See [TGA Men's Competition Policies](#) for complete details.

'One-Seat' Policy: When riding in a golf cart, there may not be more than two (2) riders per cart at any time. The player can ride in or move a golf cart with another player's caddie in it, so long as the player whose caddie is in the cart is not riding in another cart at the same time. Transferring Qualifying Sites: Changing a qualifying site is permissible, ONLY before the tournament entry deadline of Wednesday, July 22 at 5:00 PM. Or, if a player is entered in a Texas Mid-Amateur qualifier and the entry deadline has passed and circumstances arise that would cause him to miss his assigned qualifier, he may follow the "Walk-Up Procedure". Withdraw from Qualifying: Players needing to withdraw from their respective qualifying site should contact TGA Tournament Coordinator, [Mollie-Jo Crain](#), or TGA Senior Tournament Director, [Chris Untiedt](#), ahead of their scheduled qualifier. Players failing to contact the TGA prior to their qualifier date will not be eligible for a refund or the "Walk-Up Procedure".

Score Posting: At the conclusion of qualifying, each player's score will be automatically posted by the TGA as a 'C', or Competition score, to their World Handicap System GHIN number. Please do not enter your own score from the qualifying round as this will result in a double post.
